Dear Owner/Tenant: On inspection or identification we have confirmed Bed Bug activity within your unit or home. In order for us to perform the best treatment we can, we ask you to please complete the following:

- \* **Please** tidy and organize any items on the floor **especially** near beds and couches.
- \* **Please** reduce any unnecessary clutter, especially cardboard boxes, loose papers, etc. Be careful how you dispose of infested items, they should be sealed in a plastic bag.
- \* **Please** do not bag anything other than bedding or items marked for disposal, you may hide bed bugs and complicate treatments.
- \* **Access** to electrical plugs and wall edges especially near beds and couches is required.
- \* **Please** do as much as physically possible to help us solve your bed bug problem.
- \* **Further treatment preparation requirements may be given after our initial service.**

**BEFORE OR AFTER TREATMENT, ALL BEDDING AND PILLOWS MUST BE HOT LAUNDERED, OR PUT THROUGH THE HOT CYCLE OF THE DRYER FOR 20-30 MIN. DO NOT OVER PACK DRYERS.**

If units are not in a state where our service technicians can lift and turn furniture, or clutter is interfering with treatments, we may not be able to solve your bed bug problem.

## Information Sheet for Occupants of indoor areas treated with Temprid SC.

**This area has been treated with Temprid SC (Reg. No. 32524), containing the active ingredients imidacloprid and beta-cyfluthrin.**

- Bystanders and animals must not be present during application.
- **Do not re-enter the treated area until at least 6 hours after the product has been applied.**
- Ventilate treated areas, either by opening windows and doors or through the use of air exchange/ventilation systems confirmed to be operational. Use fans where required to aid in the circulation of air.

The following adverse effects have been reported following re-entry into areas treated with products containing beta-cyfluthrin: respiratory effects such as cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath nausea, dizziness, eye irritation.
